#### MARKTPLATZ

On **MARKTPLATZ** square, you'll find a large soccer court, fan matches, teqball, table football, a photo booth and a Tutu ball wall, while face painting and a social wall add to the fun. Highlight: the illuminated football player and the giant trophy.

#### KARLSPLATZ

It's all about culture and music on **KARLSPLATZ** square. Music, dance and theatre are the order of the day here. A chillout area and a beach soccer pitch keep things fresh, and there is a wide selection of vegetarian and vegan dishes on offer.

#### SCHILLERPLATZ

The fan zone on **SCHILLERPLATZ** square is the place to be for food and drink. Here you can try a wide range of regional specialities and typical Swabian dishes. The ideal spot for a break and a bite to eat!




